

BUILDING A SUSTAINABLE HEALTH INFORMATION SYSTEM

Working in close collaboration with federal and regional government and partners, APC contributed to establishing and strengthening new and existing components of the health information system.



SYSTEMS AT A GLANCE

Health Management Information System (HMIS)/eHMIS/District **Health Information Software 2 (DHIS2)**

Used to manage health information through data collection, validation, analysis, and presentation



Community Health Information System (CHIS)/eCHIS Used by Health Extension Workers to manage family/client data



Electronic Multi-sectoral Response Information System (eMRIS) Used by HIV/AIDS Prevention and Control Offices to collect non-clinical HIV data



Electronic Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (eIDSR) Used for early detection of epidemics



Electronic Medical Catalog System (eMCS)

Used for patient registration and appointment management



National Medical Service Directory (NMSD)/Emergency and Referral Information System (ERIS)

Used for management of emergency data and referrals



Health Net

Used to connect health facilities with Internet access and VPN


